1. Organisation

2. Registration

Please make your registration for the Granfondo San Gottardo 2024 online on our website. If you have any problems with your registration, please contact info@granfondosangottardo.com

Registration deadline and fees:

- from 01.08.2024 until 30.11.2024 = CHF 55.00 online registration
- from 01.12.2024 until 28.02.2025 = CHF 60.00 online registration
- from 01.03.2025 until 30.04.2025 = CHF 65.00 online registration
- from 01.05.2025 until 30.06.2025 = CHF 75.00 online registration
- from 01.07.2025 until 19.07.2025 = CHF 80.00 on-site registration available

Small loop:

- from 01.08.2024 until 30.11.2024 = CHF 45.00 online registration
- from 01.12.2024 until 28.02.2025 = CHF 55.00 online registration
- from 01.03.2025 until 30.04.2025 = CHF 60.00 online registration
- from 01.05.2025 until 30.06.2025 = CHF 65.00 online registration
- from 01.07.2025 until 19.07.2025 = CHF 70.00 on-site registration available

If a registered participant cannot attend, the registration fee will not be refunded. In this context, we would like to point out that there is an option to take out cancellation insurance when registering online.

If a registered participant cannot take part, the registration fee will not be refunded. Cancellation insurance for the paid entry fee can be taken out on request at the time of registration. In the event of illness or accident, the insured person will be credited with the paid entry fee on presentation of a medical certificate. Entitlement to reimbursement is only valid if cancellation costs insurance and a medical certificate are available.

If the race cannot be held or can only be held partially due to force majeure, extraordinary risks or official orders, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.



- 3. Registration fee** The registration fee includes:
- timekeeping
 - starting package with goodies and various regional products
 - bib number
 - neutral race service
 - emergency number
 - feeding zones on the course
 - finisher meal in the finish area
 - hot shower service in the finish area and changing room
 - personal diploma
 - rankings
 - free parking spaces for cars, motorhomes and caravans as well as tents are reserved in the finish area (from Saturday 19.07.2025, 10:00 am to Sunday, 20.07.2025, 07:00 pm)
 - photo service by Sportograf
- 4. Payment conditions** Online registrations must be paid by credit card or bank directly on the following website:

- 5. Late registration** Late registration is possible up to 60 minutes before the start of the race. Compared to the online registration, a late registration fee of CHF 10 is due.
- 6. Distribution of bib number and start package** The bib numbers will be issued on Saturday, July 19, 2025, from 15:00 pm to 18:00 pm and Sunday, 20 July, 2025, from 07:00 am to 08:30 am. The bib numbers will be issued at the Gottardo Arena in Ambri.
The goodie bag and medal can be obtained in the finish.

ATTENTION:

Failure to collect the bib number during the prescribed times means withdraw from the start.

The goodie bag can be collected by third parties on presentation of the voucher on the bib number.

The bib number is exclusively for the registered person and is not transferable to third parties.

7. Race course

The Granfondo San Gottardo provides for two different routes:

Long route: 115 km, 3'300 meters of elevation

Ambri – Tremola – St. Gotthardpass – Hospental – Furkapass – Ulrichen – Nufenenpass – Ambri

Short route: 52 km, 1'500 meters of elevation

Ambri – Tremola – St. Gotthardpass – Airolo – Stalvedro – Madrano – Ronco – Quinto – Ambri

The race routes are specially signposted.

The routes are signposted as follows:

The long route is marked with **red** signposts and timekeeping is installed in the following sections:

- **Section 1: Airolo – Gotthardpass**
- **Section 2: Realp – Furkapass**
- **Section 3: Ulrichen – Nufenenpass**

The short route is marked with **yellow** signposts and timekeeping is installed in the following sections:

- **Section 1: Airolo – Gotthardpass**
- **Section 2: Stalvedro – Ronco**

Each participant can choose the route that suits them best after the first section on condition that they complete it within the time allotted for the route. It is not permitted to switch from the short route to the long route. No entry fee will be refunded if you switch to the other route.

8. Start meeting point **Meeting point: on July 20, 2025, at 08:30 am** in the starting area in Ambri.

10. Helmet

Wearing a helmet is obligatory for all categories.

11. Light

Carrying a front (white) and rear light (red) is obligatory for participants and must be carried.



12. Timekeeping

Timekeeping will be carried out by Raceresult. Timekeeping is carried out with a chip integrated in the bib number.

Timekeeping will only take place on the climbs to the Gotthard, Furka and Nufenen passes (long route) or to the Gotthard pass and Ronco (short route). The rest of the course is neutralised.

The time of the individual sections will be measured individually.

13. Time limits

Long route:

- Arrival on the Gotthardpass by 11:00 am at the latest
- Start timekeeping Furkapass in Realp by 11:30 am at the latest
- Arrival on the Furkapass by 13:00 pm at the latest
- Start timekeeping Nufenenpass in Ulrichen by 14:00 pm at the latest
- Arrival on the Nufenenpass by 16:00 pm at the latest
- Finish in Ambri by 16:45 pm at the latest

Short route:

- Arrival on the Gottardpass by 11:30 am at the latest
- Start timekeeping in Stalvedro to Ronco by 12:15 pm at the latest
- Arrival in Ronco by 13:00 at the latest
- Finish in Ambri by 13:30 at the latest

Important:

Participants, who do not reach the time limits will be withdrawn from the race.

- 14. rankings and prizes** The ranking list consists of the sum of the times of the sections. Awards will be given to the first 3 overall winners in the men's and women's categories as well as to the first classified in each category on the long and short course, provided that the race course has been completed in the specified minimum time. No ranking list will be drawn up for category I.

The prizes will only be handed out at the award ceremony, there will be no shipping.

15. General rules for participation

By joining, the participant confirms:

- that he/she has read the regulations and accepts them in their entirety
- that he/she is familiar with the basic principles of the event and that he/she is in a mental and physical condition appropriate for the event
- that he/she will comply with the regulations and the instructions of the race management and the staff in charge.
- that he/she allows his/her personal data to be used by the organisers
- that he/she agrees to the use of pictures, films and recordings of his/her participation in the event for all lawful purposes, including advertising purposes
- that he/she waives any claim for liability or damages against the Organiser, its partners or suppliers, staff of any rank, sponsors and promoters arising from his/her participation in the Event or side events.

Furthermore:

- that the organisers accept no liability in the event of non-compliance with these regulations.
- that the organisers may at any time and without appeal decide whether or not to accept an entry; or to exclude an entered competitor from the race if he/she is likely to cause damage to the image of the event.
- that all participants shall behave in a fair and sportsmanlike manner during the race and at the start.
- only racing bicycles without electronic assistance (such as e-bikes) are permitted, exception category e-bike.

16. Road rules, time and place of road closure

The bike race is accompanied by motorcycles. These are uniformly marked. Road traffic regulations must be observed along the entire route.

A limited driving ban for motorized vehicles is only guaranteed on the following sections:

- **Airolo – Gotthardpass, from 09:00 am to 11:30 am.**
- **Stalvedro – Ronco, from 10:30 am to 13:00 pm.**

All other sections are passable as normal but will be controlled by Granfondo staff and the police.

The descents and remaining sections between the timed sections are neutralized.

From the passage of the first motorcycle until the passage of the “Besenwagen”, neither unregistered cyclists nor companions or other third parties may join the race or move in the field of riders. If a rider is assisted by a third party during the race, the participant will be disqualified immediately.

The “Besenwagen” (end of the bike race) will adhere to the maximum passage times.

Any late riders will be allowed to continue on the race course and must abide by the traffic rules. However, there will no longer be a technical and medical service available to them.

17. Insurance

Each participant must have his/her own insurance for non-occupational accidents as well as private liability insurance, for foreigners this must also include a clause for abroad. The organisers disclaim any liability.

18. Feeding

Feeding along the race course is guaranteed exclusively in the zones provided by the organizers. Waste can be disposed of at the refreshment stations. Littering is prohibited and will be punished with a time penalty or may lead to disqualification.



- 19. Technical support** Technical support is guaranteed along the race tracks. It is forbidden to follow racers in private cars. This also applies to non-registered cyclists. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.
- 20. Medical support** Medical care is guaranteed along the course.
- 21. Doping** Participants sanctioned by the UCI for doping will be refused registration. This is an unappealable decision of the organiser. The use of doping is strictly prohibited.
- 22. Parking, camping and caravans, tents** The parking areas and tent zone are located at Ambri airfield. This is ideal for parking camping and caravans.
- 23. Disqualification** Participation with the bib number of another participant, the handing over of bib number to third parties, or other serious circumstances determined by the organisers will lead to disqualification. Failure to observe the traffic rules and regulations and disregarding the security personnel may be reasons for disqualification.
- 24. Cancellation of the race** The race will take place in all weather conditions, except in exceptional cases that endanger the participants or in the event of natural disasters. In this case, the organizing committee will decide whether the participation fees will be refunded or credited to the following year.
- 25. Environmental protection** All participants should behave in an environmentally friendly manner. Leaving litter of any kind on the entire race course is prohibited. Littering will be penalized and will result in a time penalty or disqualification.
- 26. Jury, complaints** The jury will only accept complaints if they are made in the regular manner within 30 minutes after the final results list has been issued and if a deposit of CHF 100.00 (one hundred) is paid beforehand. If the complaint is accepted, the deposit will be refunded.
- 27. Regulations** The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to the race course and regulations at any time. The changes will be published on the official website.
- 28. Further information** The latest information will be communicated when the bib numbers are collected. This information will also be published on the official website and on social media.

The official website, www.granfondosangottardo.com, provides further information about the routes, the course of the event and about side events that are organised for both participants and accompanying persons.
